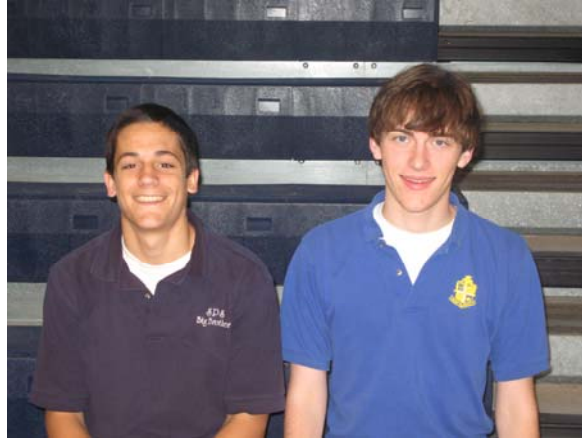

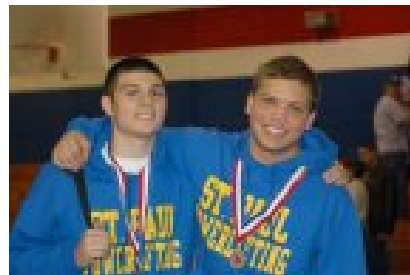
National Merit Scholarship
