

**SAINT PAUL'S SCHOOL

The Junior-Senior Prom is an SPS school function for members of the 11th & 12th grade classes.

Date: Saturday, May 2, 2015 **Band:** Neutral Snap

Place: The Abita Quail Farm, 23185 HWY 435, Abita Springs, LA 70420

Time: 7:30 PM Prom begins -- dinner is served
 8:30 PM **ALL MUST BE AT PROM;** NO ONE ADMITTED AFTER 8:30
 Excuses such as "my limo got lost" or "the restaurant was crowded"
 are NOT ACCEPTABLE for being late
 11:00 PM End of lock-in. **ALL MUST STAY UNTIL 11:00.**
 11:30 PM End of prom.

Dress: For males, tuxedo is norm, but not necessary. For females, dresses may be full-length or no shorter than 4 inches above the knee. Slits in dresses may be no more than 4 inches above the knee. Dresses may not have an open back or lace up the back. There should be no immodest cutouts, openings, or low cut, revealing necklines. Spaghetti straps, one shoulder and strapless dresses are allowed. No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes.

Cost: \$60 per couple. This is what it costs us to put on the prom at the Abita Quail Farm. Please note that the cost of the prom **includes** an extensive food buffet. The menu is printed below. You can reduce your prom costs by not eating a big meal at an expensive restaurant. We are starting the prom at 7:30 to encourage students to forego expensive restaurants and eat at the prom.

Prom Rules:

- * **All students and dates will be Breathalyzed.**
- * **All of the rules of the Saint Paul's School apply, especially rules concerning alcohol / drugs. I continue to be concerned about the alcohol / drug consumption by some of our students. Over the past few years we have had one student die and at least four others brought to hospital emergency rooms due to alcohol overdose. We will be especially vigilant this year, and cars may be inspected by police officers as they arrive at the prom. If you want to drink, do NOT come to the prom. I am pleading with parents to assist us in reinforcing this message. Thanks for your cooperation.**
- * Saint Paul's students are responsible for the conduct of their dates, including appropriate dress. No chewing gum.
- * Saint Paul's assumes no responsibility for before or after prom parties. These are the responsibility of the sponsors of the party. Saint Paul's does not condone any teenage activity where alcohol is served or allowed.
- * Saint Paul's does not approve of the rental of hotel rooms by students. We also discourage students from "heading to the French Quarter" after the prom.
