Louisiana Tiger Legacy Scholarship (NEW fall 2016)

- Child of an LSU graduate or current LSU employee
- 24 ACT or 1160 New SAT or 1090 Old SAT (CR+M)
- Current value: \$500, \$750, or \$1,000 per year

Bogalusa Scholarship

- **Purpose:** Through the generosity of the people who live in Washington Parish, the Northshore Community Foundation is able to award scholarships to Bogalusa High School students who want to pursue higher education.
- **Information:** The Bogalusa Scholarship Fund was created in 1999 to exist as a permanent scholarship fund. The scholarship is overseen by the Northshore Community Foundation in order to take advantage of the foundation's management expertise. According to the original articles of incorporation that continue to guide the Fund, income generated by the Fund is to provide cash scholarships to assist selected graduating/graduated high school students who will enroll in a college or university. The scholarship award is to be used toward the following, in order of priority: tuition and fees; room and board; books and supplies; and commuting expenses. The recipients are to be selected by an independent Scholarship Advisory Committee that is appointed by the Foundation.

Northlake Mandeville Rotary Club College Scholarship

Students that qualify for the Rotary scholarship will have exemplified outstanding academic achievement and participated in serving our community through various volunteer, school, and civic organizations. In addition those students that exhibit financial need will also receive special consideration. **Our scholarship goal is to find a worthy student where our scholarship will make a difference in helping them realize their potential as a student and a member of our community.**

The Rotary Scholarship is a \$12,000 award, paid to the college of the recipient's choice in \$1500 semester installments for a maximum of 8 semesters. The student must be full time as defined by the college they are attending and maintain a 2.5 GPA. The student will be invited to attend a Rotary meeting twice a year to report on their activities and to pick up their scholarship check. South Slidell Swimming Scholarship Fund

- **Purpose:** The South Slidell Swimming Scholarship Fund was established in 2009 by the Lakeside Swim Association, Inc. through the Northshore Community Foundation. The purpose of the Fund is to provide scholarships to high school senior(s) who participated in either the Salmen High School Swim Team or the St. Tammany Swim League located at 497 Cumberland Street (formerly called Lakeside Swim Team) to offset educational expenses to any accredited two and/or four year college or university. The Fund's primary objective is to award one scholarship to a Salmen High School student and one scholarship to a St. Tammany Swim League team student.
- **Information:** The Fund will make available a one-time scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to two qualified candidates who will attend an accredited, two and/or four year, college or university. The scholarship award is to be used toward the following in the order of priority: tuition and fees; room and board; books and supplies; and commuting expenses. The recipients are to be selected by a Scholarship Advisory Committee.

KEY Dates:

- Deadline for submitting the Pre-Candidate Questionnaire online is December 31.
- Congressional representatives and other nominating entities submit nominations to the Academy between December 1 and January 31.
- Applications for our Summer Seminar program are open from December 1 through January 15. This program gives high school juniors a chance to see what life at the United States Air Force Academy is really like. Limited spaces are available.
- **Rolling Deadlines:** Applicants' specific deadlines to complete their file is posted on their portal. They must complete the required items by the deadline posted.

Who Are We Looking For?

The United States Air Force Academy strives to create a highly qualified and truly diverse cadet wing at the Academy each year. In addition to diversity in terms of race, ethnicity and gender, we are looking to expand our applicant pool across individual characteristics defined by our diversity definition, including:

- Personal life experiences, including having overcome adversity by personal efforts
- Geographic background, such as region, rural, suburban, urban
- Socioeconomic and educational background, such as academic excellence and/or whether an individual would be a first generation college student
- Cultural knowledge and language abilities, with particular emphasis on cultures and languages of strategic importance to the Air Force
- Work background, including prior enlisted service
- Physical abilities, including athletic prowess
- Age, though applicants must be within statutory parameters for academy attendance

During a Student's Junior Year

Junior year is when the application process to the United States Air Force Academy truly begins. Students will start by filling out the Pre-Candidate Questionnaire, which becomes available online March 1 every year and starts the application process. When a student is ready to begin the application, they can visit the Pre-Candidate Questionnaire online.

Between March 1 of their junior year and December 31 of their senior year, they must also request nominations from their state's congressional representative(s) or other designated nominators.

We take a holistic view of our applicants. They're more than a GPA or standardized test score. We're looking for students who have a desire to serve and seek an education that is on par with highly selective colleges and universities. For our top diversity candidates, we offer the Falcon Visitation Experience. This opportunity gives prospective students an opportunity to spend three days on our campus to get a first-hand look at what United States Air Force Academy life is like.
