# AP SCHOLARS

Saint Paul's School is proud to announce that Jeffrey Coote, Christian Chaney, Daniel Scharmer, Jared Coe, Christos McGraw, and Bryan Rozycki, graduates of the class of 2009, have been recognized as AP Scholars by the College Board based on their outstanding academic performance on Advanced Placement Exams. The College Board's Advanced Placement Program provides academically prepared students with the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school, and to earn college credit. Jeffrey Coote qualified for the AP Scholar Award by earning an average grade of 3.0 or higher scale on all of the AP Exams he took in his junior and senior years. Christian Chaney and Daniel Scharmer have been awarded the AP Scholar with Honor Award by earning an average grade of 3.25 or higher on all AP Exams taken, and a grade of 3.0 or higher on at least four AP exams taken in their high school career. Jared Coe, Christos McGraw, and Bryan Rozycki have been awarded the AP Scholar with Distinction Award by earning an average grade of 3.5 on all of the AP Exams taken and grades of 3.0 or higher on five or more exams taken in their high school careers. More than 3,600 colleges and universities participate in the program and recognize credit and honors awarded with this program.
