Saint Paul's School Homecoming Dances Rules and Procedures Please keep this information for your reference

- To attend a Saint Paul's School Dance, young ladies must be accompanied by a Saint Paul's Student.
- Students must agree to abide by the rules and procedures, turn in a completed Guest Registration Form (see previous page) and \$30.00 to be registered for the dance. **Due dates are listed on registration form.** A late fee of \$5.00 will be required if both the registration form and fee are turned in late.
- All school rules of behavior will be enforced. Saint Paul's students are responsible for making their
 guests aware of school rules and policies. Everyone in attendance must conduct himself or herself
 in a positive and respectful manner. Students are expected to dress appropriately and adhere to
 the school's dress code. A violation of the dress code will result in a phone call to the
 student's parents and dismissal from the dance. (see dress code below)
- Rules for appropriate dancing will be enforced. If a student does not respond cooperatively to a chaperone's request to dance appropriately, a phone call will be made to the student's parents and the student will be dismissed from the dance. Cars, limousines, and buses are subject to search by school and law enforcement authorities.
- No gum will be allowed in the Briggs Assembly Center.
- Students/guests attending the 10th/11th/12th dance will be required to pass a breathalyzer test before entering the dance; if a student/guest fails the breathalyzer test, a parent must escort the student/guest home from the dance. The breathalyzer test will be administered a drug screening company hired by SPS.

Dress Code

• Saint Paul's students must wear a tie, long pants, and dress shirt. Coats are not required but are allowed. Shirts are to remain tucked in and ties must remain on throughout the dance. Young ladies may wear formal or semi-formal dresses with a modest and appropriate fit. Hemlines for short dresses must be no more than 4 inches above the knee. Slits in dresses must be no more than 4 inches above the knee. Dresses may not have an open back or lace up the back. There should be no immodest cutouts, openings, or low cut, revealing necklines. Spaghetti straps, one-shoulder and strapless dresses are allowed. No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes.
