Dear Friends of Saint Paul's School

During 2018, we celebrate the 100th anniversary of Christian Brother presence at Saint Paul's School, which began in 1918 when the Brothers brought the Lasallian Mission to our beloved school. After being exiled from France in 1904 and having barely escaped with their lives from Mexico in the 1914 revolution, the Brothers purchased the school from the Benedictine monks of Saint Joseph Abbey in 1918. And the rest, as they say, is history.

Our Lasallian Centennial so far has been marked by many milestones -- thanks in part to the support of so many. The 2018 graduating class was one of the largest in school history. A near-record number of pre-freshmen applied in 2018, proving our school's continued value, viability, and relevance. Your donations made a difference, too. With your help, Saint Paul's continued to spread the Christian Brothers' Lasallian education to the next generation of young men, and here are just some of our students' accomplishments:

- ▶ Thirty-four students over the last four years have earned the distinction of National Merit Semi-Finalists or Commended Scholars.
- ▶ Thirty-two students were named AP Scholars last year -- an increase over the year before.
- ▶ Over 85% of our graduates in the last three years have qualified for TOPS. Last year, sixty-four graduates qualified at the Honors Level.
- ▶ The Student of the Year for the State of Louisiana was a 2017 SPS student, the non-public Student of the Year for 2016 was a Saint Paul's student, and Archdiocesan Student of the Year for 2015 was a Saint Paul's student.
- ▶ Nationally certified PLTW programs in engineering and biomedical sciences continue, thanks to our partnerships with Hornbeck Offshore Services, Inc. and Dr. David and Kathy Oubre's Ponchartrain Cancer Center.
- ▶ The soccer team made its eighth consecutive appearance in the state Division One championship game, winning the state title in five of those years and receiving a national ranking.
- ▶ Not to be outdone, basketball and lacrosse made appearances in the state championship games last year.
- ▶ We had individual state champions in wrestling and power-lifting.
- ▶ The average ACT composite score for the class of 2018 is 26 compared to the national average of 21.0, the State of Louisiana average of 19.5, and the St. Tammany

Public School average of 22.

- ▶ Three students over the past two years had perfect ACT scores of 36. Sixty-nine students over the past two years scored 30 or higher on the ACT.
- ▶ SPS recently completed construction of the latest addition to the Gene Bennett Sports Complex: a new, air-conditioned 1500 seat gym.
- ▶ And we have just completed a multi-million dollar renovation of Benilde Hall, bringing that storied, but outdated, building into the 21st Century -- which our students deserve.

Your generous donations have allowed Saint Paul's to reach the pinnacle of excellence, and because of this, Saint Paul's School was selected as a 2015 Blue Ribbon School of Excellence by the United States Department of Education, one of only three high schools in Louisiana to receive the award in 2015 and one of only 50 private high schools in the nation. The Blue Ribbon award is considered the highest honor an American school can achieve.

Know that your contributions are a significant help in making Saint Paul's, not only a Blue Ribbon School, but also a place where students "Rise Up" as men of God and practice the Five Lasallian Core Principles in their homes, on campus, and in their communities.

While you may designate your tax-deductible gift to a specific program such as financial aid or an academic program, sending an unrestricted gift allows us greater latitude in building programs.

Note, too, that those who give at the \$1000 or higher level have their names inscribed for the year on our donor board in the main school building and are invited to the President's Annual Fund Dinner in August. Naturally, anonymity can be requested. But know that we welcome gifts of any size.

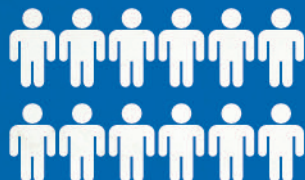

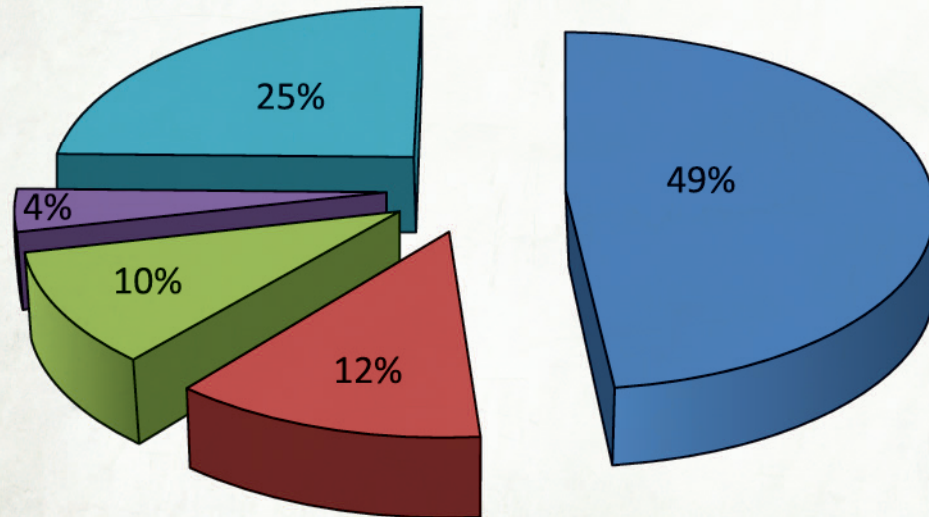

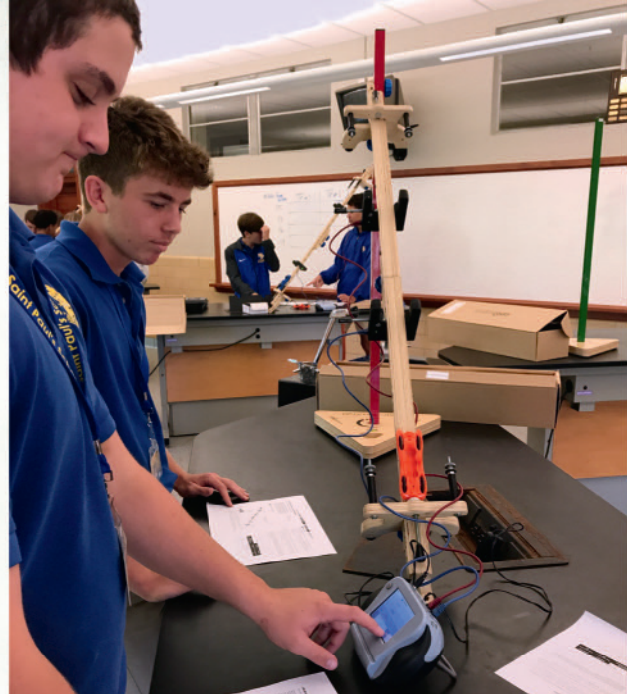

Benilde Hall Renovation

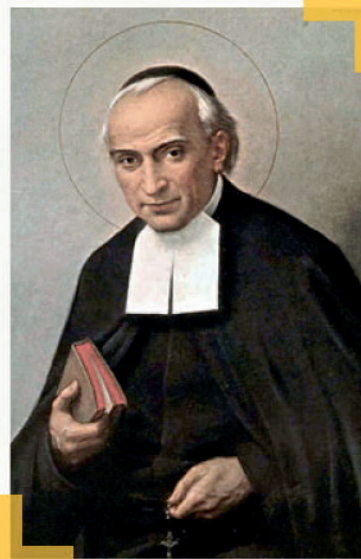
Keeping the Drive Alive!

Cost 4.8 Million

In the early 1800s, Benildus Romançon was ahead of his classmates in school. Even though he was only 14 years old, he was engaged as a substitute teacher. Despite the reluctance of the superiors, who thought he was too short to teach, he was finally admitted to the novitiate. He was sent to Saugues, an isolated village in the south of France, and worked quietly and effectively to educate the boys in the village. In time, the school became the center of social and intellectual life for the village, with evening classes for the adults and tutoring for the less gifted students. In 1967, Benilde was canonized and Pope Pius XII stressed that his sanctification was attained by "doing common things in an uncommon way."

Benilde Hall was built in 1959 under the principalship/presidency of the late Brother Cassian Lange. The second and third floors were dormitories for 6th and 7th grades. The bottom floor contained study halls and recreation rooms. When Saint Paul's dropped 6th grade, the first two floors were converted into classrooms. The third floor remained a dormitory for 7th grade. When 7th grade was dropped, the third floor became the band room! The current band room was a rec hall for the boarders. When the number of boarders started dropping, the rec hall was moved into La Salle Hall, and the third floor was converted to classrooms.

Renovation of Benilde Hall slowly began in January 2018 with the upper two floors completed for the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year. Benilde Hall is the home for updated Religion and Spanish classrooms, a media center for our thriving publications group, and a student union with a coffee shop. In addition, retail space has been provided for our bookstore. With the renovation of this facility, new configurations allow for several additional classroom spaces around campus. The entire building is surrounded by a covered breezeway to provide shelter for inclement weather. An elevator has been added in order to be ADA compliant.

The older gymnasium's maximum seating capacity is 870, which meant some students had floor seats for Brother Ray's semi-monthly assemblies. According to LHSAA regulations, in order to host a playoff game, a 5A school must have a gym with the capacity to seat 1000 people. In December of 2014, work began on the addition to the Gene Bennett Sports Complex. This 19,500 square foot air conditioned facility provides for the much needed space.

Thanks to our 2017-2018 basketball team and their historic run for the state title, the gym has been christened not only by Father Matthew Clark, OSB, but by the throngs of fans that have packed the stands to cheer our Basketball Wolves to a 30-7 record season. Every student had a good seat as the entire student body watched the Wolves advance through the semi-final game to state championship on the big screen. The doors are now open, the backboards have been battle-tested, so bring on the champions!

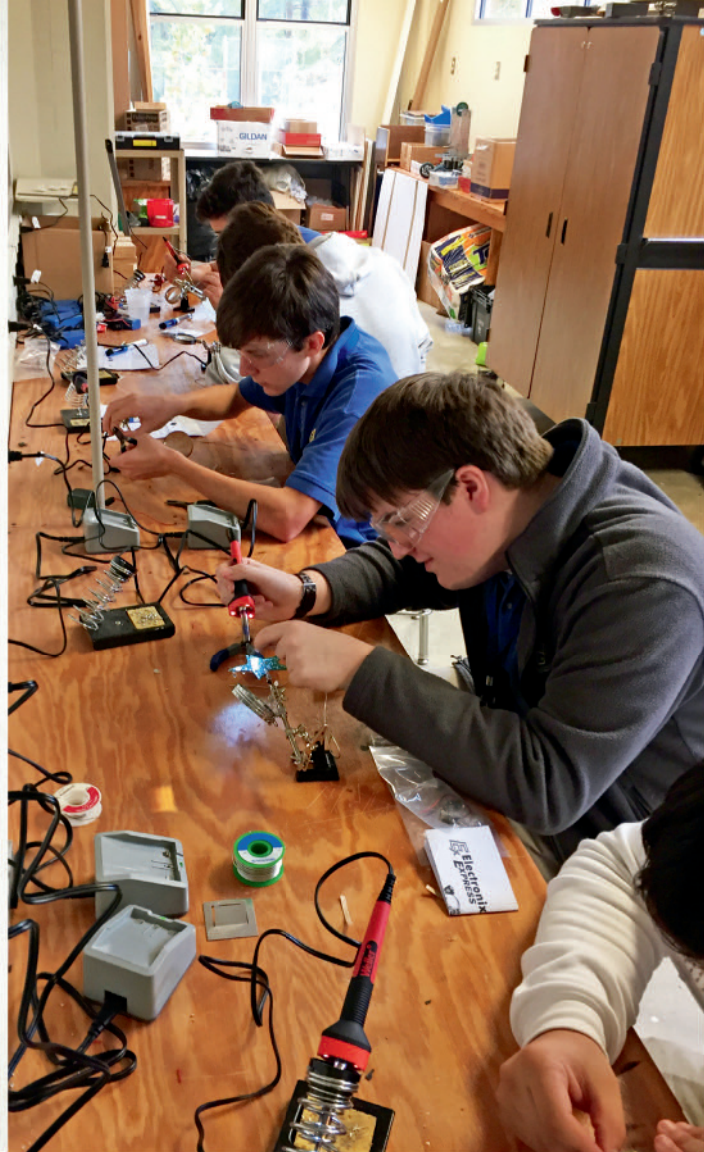


for STEM-centered or specialized academies. BMS is designed to prepare students to pursue a post-secondary education and careers in the biomedical sciences.
