

Dear Parents and Students:

Please read carefully the information concerning the upcoming Sophomore Service Day and World War II Museum Field Trip on **Thursday, November 15 and Friday, November 16.**

Each year of the St. Paul's experience, students take part in a retreat/field trip of the course of two school days. Our annual Sophomore Service Day spends one school day in service to our community throughout the Greater New Orleans Region. The other day in the rotation is spent in deepening our education at the National World War II Museum. The class will be split into two groups and the students will participate in each event but on opposite days. Here is how it works for where your son will be on both days:

WORLD WAR II MUSEUM DAY—

There is a fee for this field trip. The cost per student is \$44, which includes transportation, entry to the museum, lunch and the 4D movie Beyond All Boundaries. Lunch will be prepared by the museum and will include a sandwich, chips, fruit and water. Students are not able to order from the museum restaurants because of time restraints and the size of our group.

SOPHOMORE SERVICE DAY—

There is no cost associated with Sophomore Service Day.

WHAT TIME SHOULD HE GET TO SCHOOL?

Each day, your son is to report to the chapel at 7:45 am. From there he will be given further instruction.

Site placements will be released Thursday, November 6th. Any requests to change placement will be handled on an individual basis after service site placements are released. This year's service sites are: Giving Hope Food Pantry, New Heights Therapy Center, Northshore Food Bank, Youth Rebuilding New Orleans, Greenwalt Center, PACE New Orleans, and City Park. These site are subject to change. If changes are made, parents will be notified.
