The \$40 cost includes band and DJ, desserts, soft drinks and water.

Dress: Attire should be suitable for a Catholic high school function: For males, tuxedo is the norm, but not necessary. Suits are acceptable. For females, dresses may be full-length or no shorter than 4 inches above the knee. Slits in dresses may be no more than 4 inches above the knee. Dresses may not have a low open back. There should be no immodest cutouts, openings, or low cut, revealing necklines. Spaghetti straps, one shoulder and strapless dresses **are** allowed. No pierced body parts are to be visible except the ear lobes.

Prom Rules:

All students and dates will be Breathalyzed.

All of the rules of the Saint Paul's School apply, especially rules concerning alcohol / drugs. We continue to be concerned about the alcohol / drug consumption by some of our students. We will be especially vigilant this year, and cars may be inspected by police officers as they arrive at the prom. If you want to drink, do NOT come to the prom. We plead with parents to assist us in reinforcing this message. Thanks for your cooperation.

Saint Paul's assumes no responsibility for before or after prom parties. These are the responsibility of the sponsors of the party. Saint Paul's does not condone any teenage activity where alcohol is served or allowed.

Saint Paul's does not approve of the rental of hotel rooms by students. We also discourage students from "heading to the French Quarter" after the prom.
