1. What does Percy Jackson say is his favorite place in the world?

2. In the first chapter, Percy dreams that his friend Grover is hiding from a monster. Based on what you learn later in the story, who or what is this monster?

3. During gym class, what magical force prevents Coach Nunley from noticing when the visitors turn into monsters?

4. The letters Percy sees on the door of the taxi in Chapter Three appear jumbled. Why is this?

What do these letters probably spell out if arranged properly?

5. Who are the “Big Three” gods and what pact did they make after WWII?

According to Percy, why was this pact made?

6. List three items that Hermes gives to Percy for his journey and explain one way in which each of these items helps the heroes on their quest.

7. In the story, Percy is able to command the sea, while Tyson has great strength and keen senses of smell and hearing. Imagine you are the son or daughter of a god and possess an extraordinary ability. Describe the ability you would choose for yourself and how you might use it on the quest.

12. After Circe turns Percy into a guinea pig, she tells him he has unlocked his true self. Do you agree with Circe? If so, explain why. If not, when in the book—if ever—do you think Percy does unlock his true self?
