During 2018 - 19 school year, we celebrated the 100th anniversary of Christian Brother presence at Saint Paul's School, which began in 1918 when the Brothers brought the Lasallian Mission to our beloved school. After being exiled from France in 1904 and having barely escaped with their lives from Mexico in the 1914 revolution, the Brothers purchased the school from the Benedictine monks of Saint Joseph Abbey in 1918. And the rest, as they say, is history.

The 2019 graduating class was one of the most talented in school history. We continued to maintain a very strong enrollment, proving our school's continued value, viability, and relevance. Your donations made a difference, too. With your help, Saint Paul's continued to spread the Christian Brothers' Lasallian education to the next generation of young men.

Your generous donations have allowed Saint Paul's to reach the pinnacle of excellence, and because of this, Saint Paul's School was selected as a 2015 Blue Ribbon School of Excellence by the United States Department of Education, one of only three high schools in Louisiana to receive the award in 2015 and one of only fifty private high schools in the nation. The Blue Ribbon award is considered the highest honor an American school can achieve.

Know that your contributions are a significant help in making Saint Paul's, not only a Blue Ribbon School, but also a place where students "Rise Up" as men of God and practice the Five Lasallian Core Principles in their homes, on campus, and in their communities.

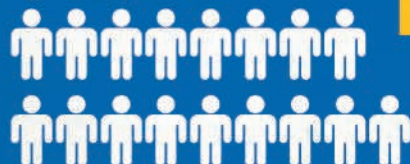

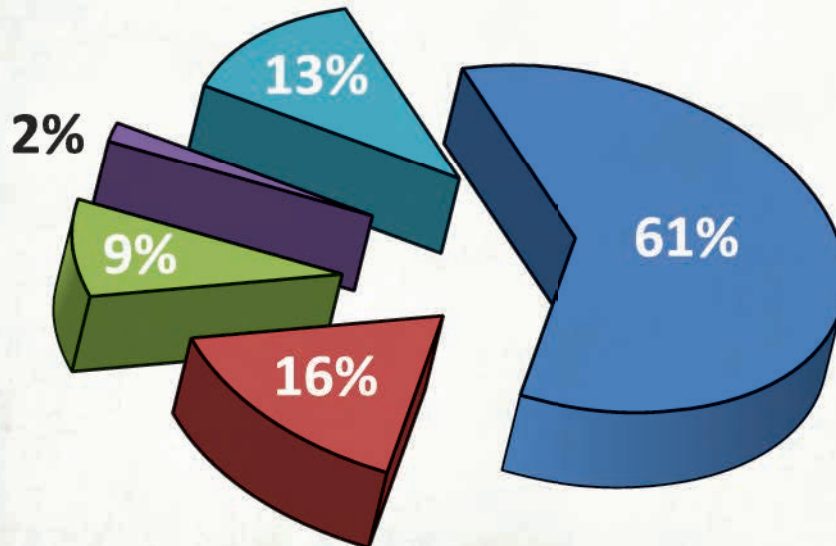

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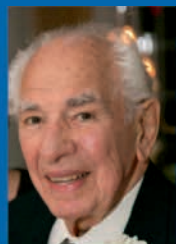

# Benilde Hall Renovation

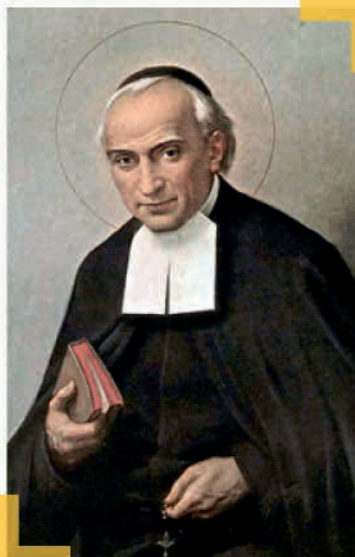
## Keeping the Drive Alive!

### Cost 4.8 Million

In the early 1800s, Benildus Romançon was ahead of his classmates in school. Even though he was only 14 years old, he was engaged as a substitute teacher. Despite the reluctance of the superiors, who thought he was too short to teach, he was finally admitted to the novitiate. He was sent to Saugues, an isolated village in the south of France, and worked quietly and effectively to educate the boys in the village. In time, the school became the center of social and intellectual life for the village, with evening classes for the adults and tutoring for the less gifted students. In 1967, Benilde was canonized and Pope Pius XII stressed that his sanctification was attained by "doing common things in an uncommon way."

Benilde Hall was built in 1959 under the principalship/presidency of the late Brother Cassian Lange. The second and third floors were dormitories for 6th and 7th grades. The bottom floor contained study halls and recreation rooms. When Saint Paul's dropped 6th grade, the first two floors were converted into classrooms. The third floor remained a dormitory for 7th grade. When 7th grade was dropped, the third floor became the band room! The current band room was a rec hall for the boarders. When the number of boarders started dropping, we moved the rec hall into La Salle Hall, and the third floor was converted to classrooms.

Renovation of Benilde Hall was completed in the fall of 2018. The Religion and Spanish classrooms on the second and third floors were extensively updated. Each classroom is equipped with a 70 inch monitor that is used for video presentations in addition to the standard 42" monitor for announcements and schedules. The first floor was completely reconfigured which includes a campus minister office, one classroom for English, another two classrooms for publications and videography, and a bookstore. In January of 2019, a PJ's coffee shop became fully functional with students from the Entrepreneur Class and the CORE Pack preparing and serving coffee. PJ's Coffee of New Orleans was instrumental in assisting us with this endeavor from conception to completion.

### Cost 4.5 Million

We've built a house for future champions! With the expansion of the student body, now 900 in number, the need for additional indoor gymnasium space became evident. The older gymnasium's maximum seating capacity is 870, which meant some students had floor seats for Brother Ray's semi-monthly assemblies. According to LHSAA regulations, in order to host a playoff game, a 5A school must have a gym with the capacity to seat 1000 people. In December of 2014, work began on the addition to the Gene Bennett Sports Complex. This 19,500 square foot air conditioned facility provides for the much needed space.

Thanks to our 2017-2018 basketball team and their historic run for the state title, the gym has been christened not only by Father Matthew Clark, OSB, but by the throngs of fans that have packed the stands to cheer our Basketball Wolves to a 30-7 record season. Every student had a good seat as the entire student body watched the Wolves advance through the semi-final game to the state championship on the big screen. Supporters of this expansion have completed their five year pledge.

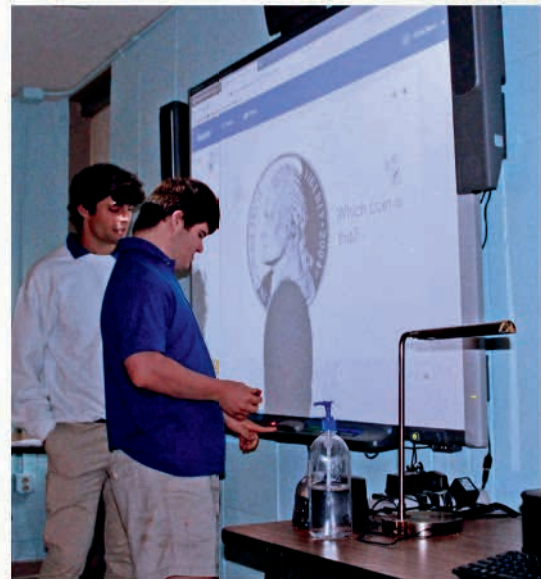
# CORE Pack

## Catholic Opportunity for a Responsive Education

One of the Lasallian Five Core Principles advocates "Inclusive Community". Beginning in the 2017-2018 school year, this pilot program was introduced in order to include children with developmental disabilities whose parents want them to have a Catholic education. It creates a program within a Catholic high school that meets the needs of those children who would not normally qualify for admission to a college preparatory school. "CORE" is an acronym for "Catholic Opportunity for a Responsive Education," while "Pack" is a nod to Saint Paul's wolf mascot.

The school day of the CORE Pack students, whose challenges include cerebral palsy, autism, Down Syndrome, fragile X syndrome and other genetic conditions, is tailored to the unique needs and interests of each boy. Each child has his own needs, so some students spend several periods in the CORE room, where they receive individual instruction in reading and math while others spend most of their day in regular classes, and simply go to the CORE room for additional support.

A key to the program's success is the large number of Saint Paul's students who have stepped up to volunteer as peer mentors.





# Project Lead The Way

**Pontchartrain Cancer Center Biomedical Science Program:** The Biomedical Sciences Program (BMS) is intended for grades nine through twelve and explores human medicine, bioinformatics, cell biology, genetics, diseases, and other biomedical topics through relevant problem-solving activities. BMS courses complement traditional science courses and can serve as the foundation for STEM-centered or specialized academies.

BMS is designed to prepare students to pursue a post-secondary education and careers in the biomedical sciences.

**Computer Science:** At a time when computer science affects how we work and live, PLTW Computer Science empowers students in grades nine through twelve to become creators, instead of merely customers, of the technology all around them. The program's interdisciplinary courses engage in compelling, real-world challenges. As students work together to design solutions, they learn computational thinking – not just how to code – and become better thinkers and communicators. Students take from the courses in-demand knowledge and skills they will use in high school and for the rest of their lives, on any career path they take. Opportunity for sponsorship is available for this track.

**The Hornbeck Offshore Gateway to Technology Program:** Designed for pre-freshmen grade students, Gateway to Technology introduces students to a variety of concepts in science, math, engineering and technology as preparation for further development throughout high school. Students use design software and robotics to solve real-world problems as well as develop communication and collaboration skills. 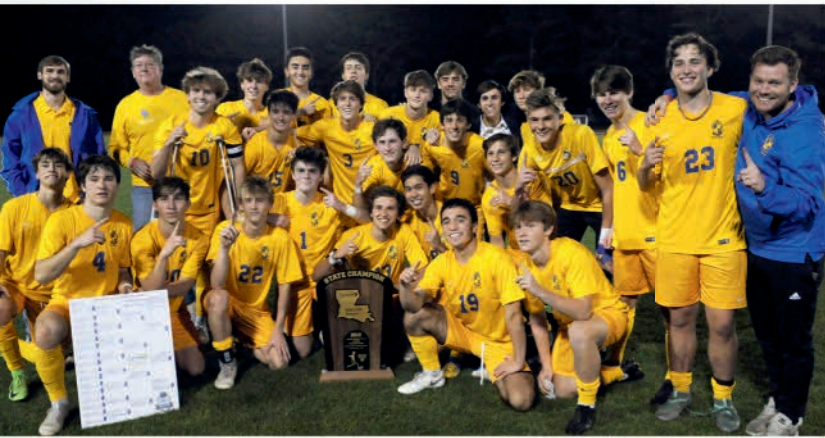
