Dear Friends of Saint Paul's School

During 2020 - 21 school year, we celebrated the 102nd anniversary of Christian Brother presence at Saint Paul's School, which began in 1918 when the Brothers brought the Lasallian Mission to our beloved school. After being exiled from France in 1904 and having barely escaped with their lives from Mexico in the 1914 revolution, the Brothers purchased the school from the Benedictine monks of Saint Joseph Abbey in 1918. And the rest, as they say, is history.

One of the first challenges the Brothers faced in 1918 was the Spanish flu pandemic, which roared through the school and community, claiming students, Brothers, and neighbors as victims. But the Brothers ministered to their students. Indeed, it was the Lasallian charism of caring for the students during this pandemic that helped win over the school's constituents to these unfamiliar French Brothers. And the rest, as they say, is history.

During 2020-21, the school was again challenged by a pandemic, which forced school closure for nine weeks in the last quarter of 2020. And while we responded with 21st century technology, it was our Lasallian creativity, caring, and competence that saved the day. Parents overwhelmingly gave "thumbs up" to our virtual school efforts during that time.

While we had hoped that the pandemic would be history as we prepared for the 2020-21 school year in August, such was not to be the case. Thus, we marshalled herculean efforts in equipping our school to be as safe and secure as possible in order to welcome our students back to campus – a desire ardently wished for by both parents and students. And thus, on August 6, 2020, we began our new school year with on-campus instruction – and remained open for every day of last school year. And the rest, as they say, is history.

As we begin a new school year in 2021-22, we again are challenged by the pandemic – and we again are meeting our obligations of keeping our students safe while providing quality education. The statistics in this brochure will give witness to that fact – as does our recently awarded Blue Ribbon School Award by the United States Department of Education – one of only two private

high schools in Louisiana to be so recognized this year, the other being our traditional sister school, Saint Scholastica Academy.

As we embark on this new school year, we do so with optimism and faith – the same optimism and faith that the Benedictine Fathers of Saint Joseph Abbey had when they opened Saint Paul's in 1911 and the same optimism and faith that the original Christian Brothers had when they assumed ownership of the school in 1918.

And as we open our new year among many uncertainties, we do so with a very strong enrollment, proving our school's continued value, viability, and relevance. Your donations made a difference, too. With your help, Saint Paul's continued to spread the Christian Brothers' Lasallian education to the next generation of young men. And we have a new band/music building, too!

Know that your contributions are a significant help in making Saint Paul's, not only a Blue-Ribbon School, but also a place where students "Rise Up" as men of God and practice the Five Lasallian Core Principles in their homes, on campus, and in their communities.

And now we call on you again, perhaps more so than ever with the uncertainties of the future. For Saint Paul's to continue to thrive, we need your help.

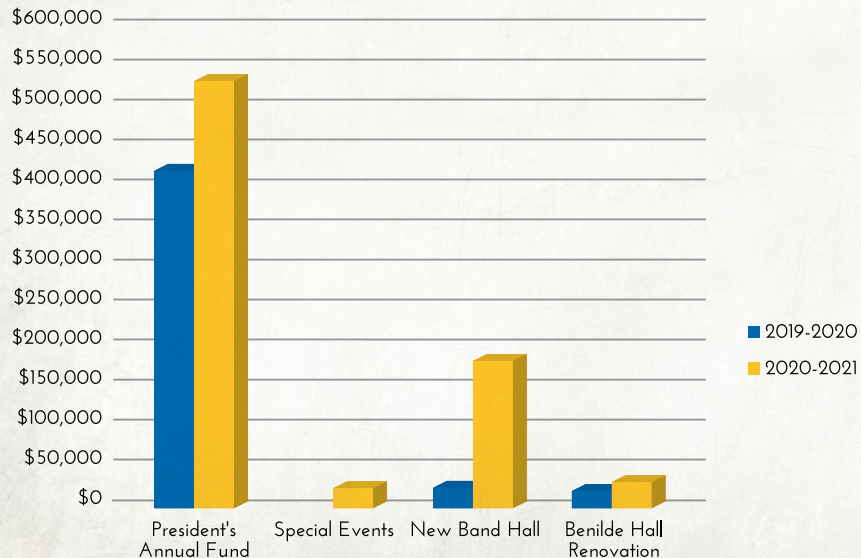

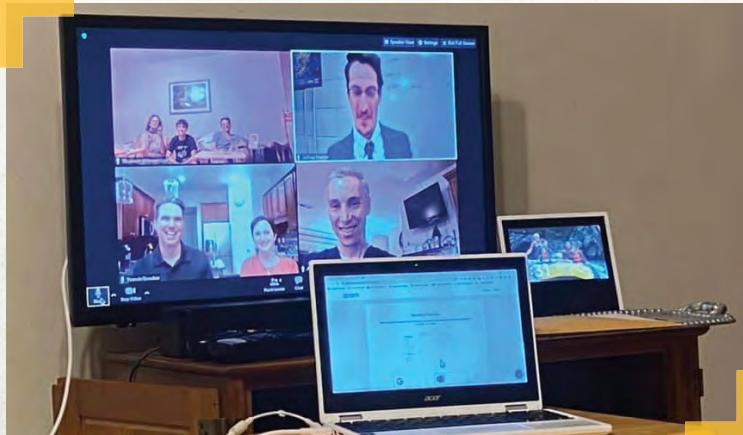

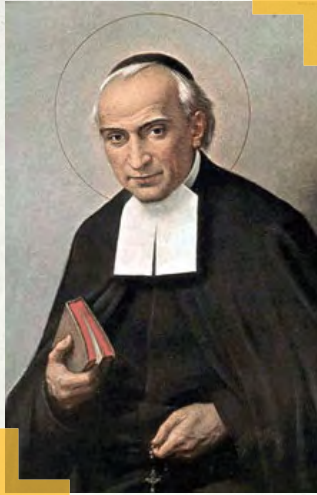

Benilde Hall Renovation

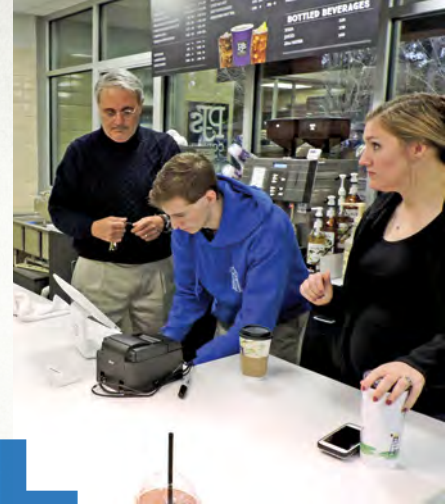
Benilde Hall was built in 1959 under the principalship/presidency of the late Brother Cassian Lange. The second and third floors were dormitories for 6th and 7th grades. The bottom floor contained study halls and recreation rooms. When Saint Paul's dropped 6th grade, the first two floors were converted into classrooms. The third floor remained a dormitory for 7th grade. When 7th grade was dropped, the third floor became the band room! When the number of boarders started dropping, the third floor was converted to classrooms.

Renovation of Benilde Hall was completed in the Fall of 2018. The Religion and Spanish classrooms on the second and third floors were extensively updated. Each classroom is equipped with a 70 inch monitor that is used for video presentations in addition to the standard 42" monitor for announcement and schedules. The first floor

was completely reconfigured which includes a campus minister office, one classroom for English, another two classrooms for publications and videography, and a bookstore. In January of 2019, a PJ's coffee shop became fully functional with students from the Entrepreneur Class preparing and serving coffee. PJ's Coffee of New Orleans was instrumental in assisting us with this endeavor from conception to completion. Supporters of this renovation are continuing their five year pledge.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, the coffee shop closed interior service to adhere to the mandated restrictions. After the new year when the pandemic seemed to be easing, service was moved outside. In March, faculty member and coffee shop moderator, Mr. Brian Logarbo, suddenly passed away; therefore, the coffee shop was closed for the remainder of the school year.

We look forward to resuming a normal coffee shop schedule in the next year.

New Band Hall Building

In the summer of 1966, the school constructed a new "recreation center" exclusively dedicated to the recreational needs of the students living in La Salle Hall dormitory. At a cost of \$15,000, a building was constructed to provide for ping pong, pool, table games and TV for the boarders. Eventually, arcade-type games and a snack bar were added. In addition, a nine-hole miniature golf (putt-putt) course was built in front of the building, complete with lighting for nighttime use.

The facility, known simply as "the rec hall", served the recreational needs of the boarding students until the summer of 1995, when, once again, the needs of the school dictated change. The overall population of the school was growing, but the population of the boarding program was shrinking. Accordingly, the decision was made to move the "rec hall" into La Salle Hall itself and to move the band hall (which was located on the third floor of Benilde Hall) into the rec hall building, thus allowing us to construct five more classrooms in Benilde Hall. The miniature golf course had also deteriorated and was removed.

The building has served the Marching Wolves well since that time, but, again, needs dictate change. In addition to overall building deterioration, our band programs have been expanding of late and now include concert, jazz, and drum corps components in addition to the renowned Marching Wolves, now almost one hundred members strong! They are deserving of a better facility.

This new facility will provide expanded space, restrooms, acoustics, and aesthetics to our music program. Construction began in the fall of 2020 and is expected to be completed in the fall of 2021.

In Memoriam

This year, Saint Paul's School lost two longtime faculty members and our beloved Bro. Alfred Baltz, FSC.



Bro. Alfred Baltz, FSC of the San Francisco New Orleans District of the De La Salle Christian Brothers passed away on September 9, 2020, at the Saint Paul's Christian Brothers Retirement Home in Covington. He was 97 years of age and had been a member of the Congregation since 1936, when he entered the junior novitiate. Bro Alfred had two brothers that were both members of the Brothers of the Christian Schools, Brother Ralph Baltz, FSC and Brother Leo Baltz, FSC.

Brother Alfred received the Habit of the Brothers on August 14, 1939, pronounced First Vows in 1940 and Final Vows in 1947. He held a B.A. from Sacred Heart Scholasticate, Las Vegas, NM. In 1961, he earned an M.S. from New Mexico Highlands University. Brother Alfred's first teaching assignment was at St. Peter's College in New Iberia. Over the course of his ministry, Brother also taught in Catholic High of New Iberia, St. Michael's High of Santa Fe, NM, Hanson High School of Franklin, LA, Kirwin High of Galveston, TX (where he was principal), Cathedral-Carmel High School in Lafayette, LA and Saint Paul's School in Covington for 34 years. He retired from teaching in 1995.

Brother Alfred was a deeply spiritual man and lived a life that balanced prayer, study and work. He was devoted to prayer and had a special devotion to the Sacred Heart. He loved to work with his hands, especially in the garden. He had a tremendous work ethic and was a master at repairing things, e.g. roofs, plumbing, and carpentry. Many people in the Covington area were recipients of his horticultural skills, and Saint Paul's School was the recipient of his carpentry skills. He was particularly delighted in building stage sets for productions. He was gentle, kind, and dignified. His life can be summed up with the words of Scripture which speaks of the faithful and prudent servant whom the Lord sets over his household. A drive-by public viewing took place in front of the Founders Oak Tree on the campus of Saint Paul's School on Saturday, September 26.





Mr. Robert Lee Simpson '88 died of pancreatic cancer on January 6, 2021, the Feast of the Epiphany. Robert attended Saint Paul's School and loved theater, played football, wrestled and enjoyed being the gregarious friend everyone loved to be around. After graduating from Saint Paul's in 1988, he attended Mississippi College and LSU, finally graduating with a degree in History from Southeastern University. In 1994 he was hired at Saint Paul's as a dorm prefect and part time history teacher. Happy to be back in the school where so much of his own formation as a Catholic man was molded, he embraced teaching in the Lasallian tradition with a surprising fervor. He loved teaching! After two years, he took time off to explore a vocation to religious life

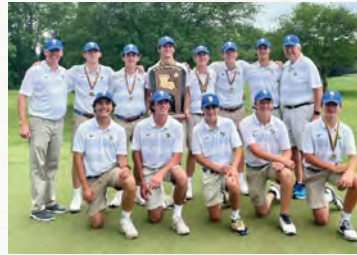
with the Benedictine monks at Saint Joseph Abbey in Covington. He entered the novitiate for a year, which he fondly remembered as the most formative, clarifying, and stabilizing time of his young adulthood. After discerning that religious life was not his calling, he was able to return to Covington in 2000 when Saint Paul's offered him a full-time position teaching religion. There he continued until the time of his death. In the twenty years of his continuous presence at Saint Paul's, he influenced and inspired countless young men in their Christian formation. Friends will remember his hearty laugh, good humor, engulfing hugs, and authentic faith. Robert has two sons who attended Saint Paul's School, Elias '20 and Gabe '22.



Mr. Brian Logarbo passed away unexpectedly on March 15, 2021. He graduated with undergraduate degrees from Louisiana State University and Southeastern Louisiana University in General Studies and Finance, respectively. He then went on to earn his MBA from Southeastern following his tenure as a manager at American Bank.
