#### The 2024-2025 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Admission Process Student in Catholic Elementary School in Archdiocese of New Orleans

### 1. Open House for Prospective Students on Saturday, October 28, 2023 from 1:00-3:00. (Optional)

2. Complete the Archdiocesan application your son will receive from his Catholic school or which you can download from the Office of Catholic Schools website (https://noladceff.org/secondary-admissions). Return form directly to your son's school by **Friday, November 10, 2023**. Principal will forward it to Saint Paul's School along with your son's school record.

3. Complete the school's online Application for Admission Form by **Tuesday, November 14,** at <u>https://forms.rediker.com/stpauls</u>. Registration fee is **NOT** due, do not **send money at this time**.

4. Upload a letter (1 page limit) through the parent portal account by **Nov 14 from the applicant** indicating why he wants to attend Saint Paul's School and how he will benefit from our program.

5. Saint Paul's School will send notification in mid-December confirming receipt of application material and providing details about **Academic Assessment Day on January 13, 2024.** 

6. Attend Academic Assessment Day on **Saturday, January 13, 2024**, beginning at 8:00 a.m. A \$30 fee is due on testing day to cover the testing cost. Parents will receive test results. The fee should be brought to testing day, not given to elementary school. No student may attend Academic Assessment Day at more than one school.

7. Students following the above procedures will be given priority in the admission process. Any application received after testing will automatically be moved to a waitlist.

8. Saint Paul's School will mail letters with admission decisions on Thursday, February 22, 2024. Registration fee will then be due at that time. Scheduling will be held in late March.

### 1. Open House for Prospective Students on Saturday, October 28, 2023 from 1:00-3:00. (Optional)

2. Complete Saint Paul's School Application for Admission Form online at <u>https://forms.rediker.com/stpauls</u>. Registration fee is <u>NOT</u> due. Send no money at this time

3. Upload the following documents through the parent portal account by **November 14:** 

- completed application
- copy of last year's final school report card
- copy of report card for current year
- copy of at least one recent standardized test
- one page letter from the applicant indicating why he wants to attend Saint Paul's School and how he will benefit from our program.

### Note: The above documents are the minimum. You may upload additional documentation if you wish.

4. Saint Paul's School will send notification in mid-December confirming receipt of application material and providing details about Academic Assessment Day on January 13, 2024.

5. Attend Academic Assessment Day on **Saturday, January 13, 2024** beginning at 8:00 a.m. A \$30 fee is due on testing day to cover the testing cost. Parents will receive test results. The fee should be brought to testing day. No student may attend **Academic Assessment Day** at more than one school.

6. Students following the above procedures will be given priority in the admission process. Applications received after testing will be placed on a waitlist.

7. Saint Paul's School will mail letters with admission decisions on Thursday, February 22, 2024. Registration fee will be due at that time. Scheduling will be held in late March.

Ninth grade spots are very limited as eighth grade is our entry level grade as per the Archdiocese of New Orleans. While we give priority for ninth grade spots to Catholic school transfers, siblings and sons of alumni, we will make every attempt to admit qualified ninth grade students.

### 1. Attend our Open House for Prospective Students on Saturday, October 28, 2023 from 1:00-3:00.(Optional)

2. Complete the Saint Paul's School Application for Admission form online at <u>https://forms.rediker.com/stpauls</u> by **November 14.** Do **NOT** send any registration fee.

#### 3. Upload the following to the parent portal account by November 14:

- completed application
- copy of last year's final school report card
- copy of current report card for this year
- copy of at least one recent standardized test
- one page letter from the applicant indicating why he wants to attend Saint Paul's School and how he will benefit from our program.

4. 9<sup>th</sup> grade applicants from non-Catholic schools are encouraged to attend **Academic Assessment Day on Saturday, January 13, 2024, at 8 am.** A \$30 fee is due on testing day to cover costs. Parents will receive test results. The fee should be brought to testing day. Coming to **Academic Assessment Day DOES NOT guarantee an offer of admission.** No student may attend Academic Assessment Day at more than one school.

5. Letters concerning a student's admission status will be mailed on **Thursday, February 22, 2024** following re-registration of our current 8th grade class which will determine how many 9th grade places are available.
