SEPTEMBER 11, 2001

On September 11, 2001, al-Qaeda terrorists carried out four coordinated attacks in the United States by hijacking commercial airplanes. Two planes were crashed into the North and South Towers of the World Trade Center, causing their collapse, while a third plane hit the Pentagon. Passengers on the fourth plane, Flight 93, fought back, and the plane crashed into a field in Pennsylvania. The attacks resulted in the deaths of 2,977 people from 93 nations.

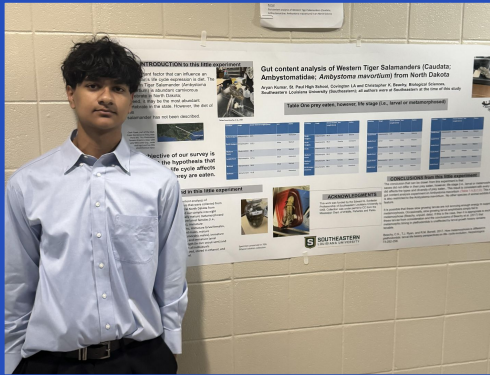
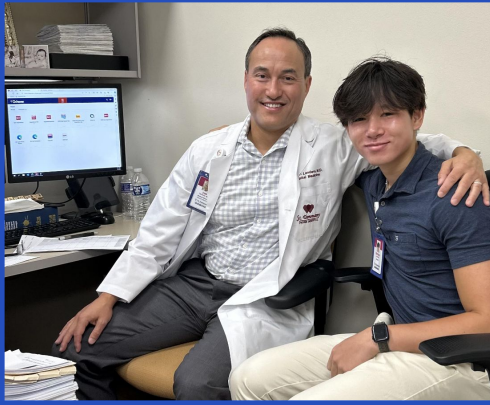
SATURDAY, AUGUST 24, 2024
