To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen.

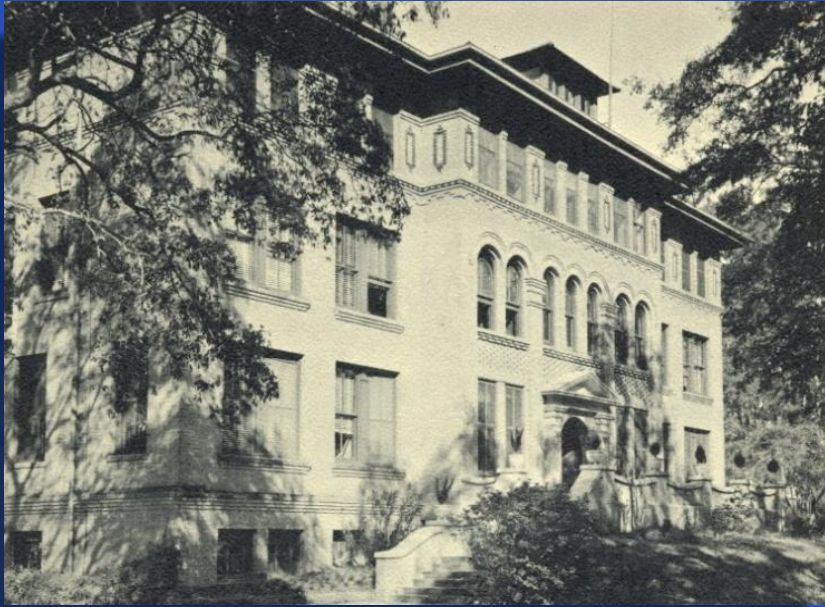

The team received the HOSA 100 Group Award and Ms. Tammy Freeman was awarded as the Outstanding HOSA Advisor.



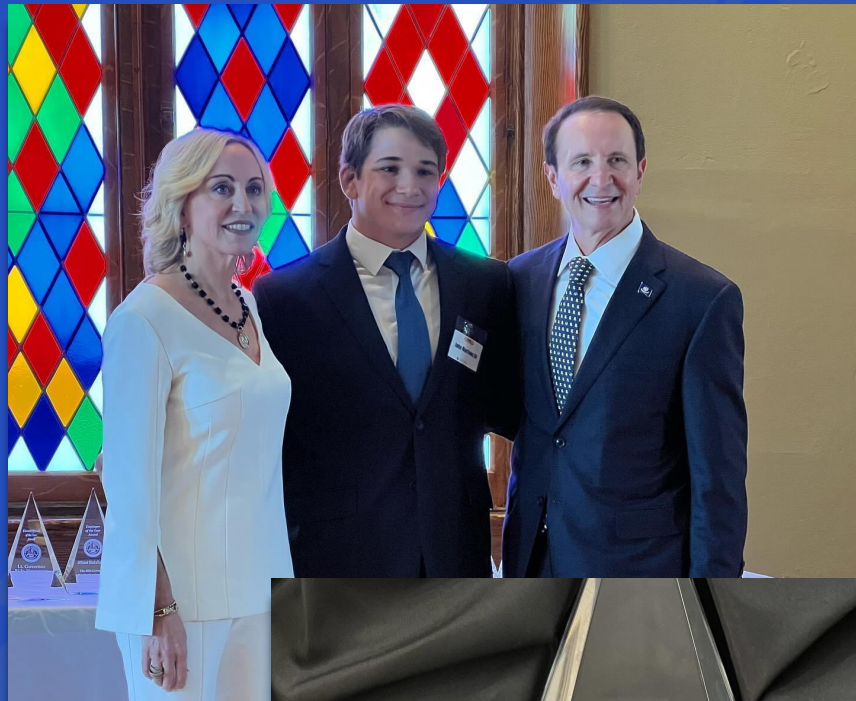
