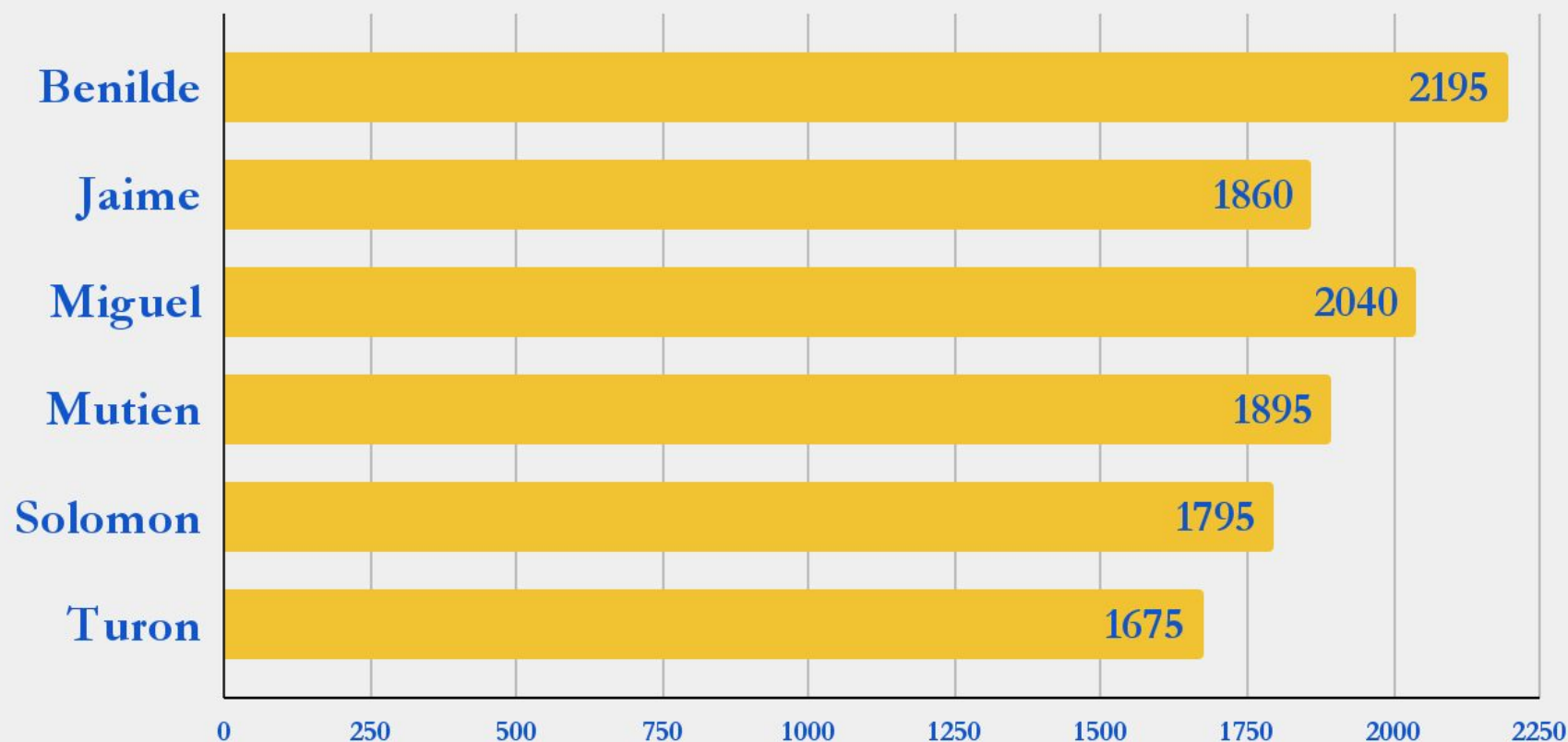

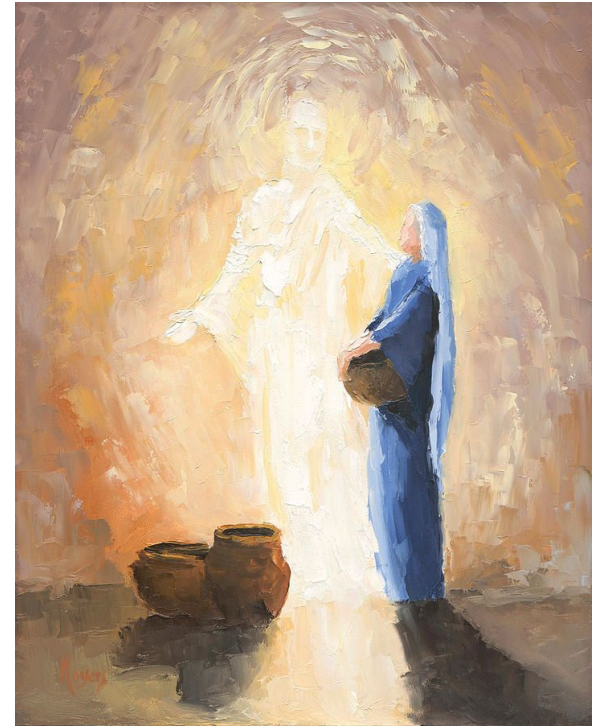




# Saint John Baptist de la Salle (Med. 112)

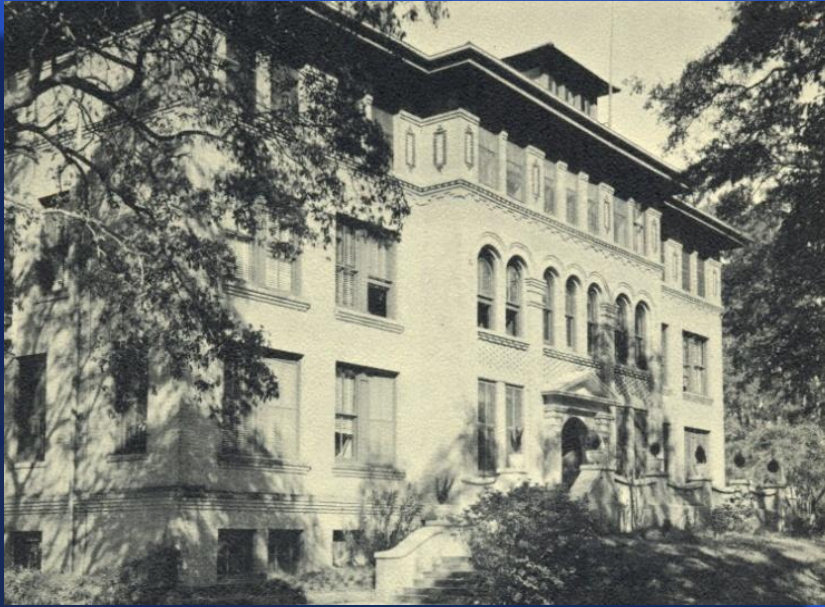

On Saturday, the students participated in the San Diego Regional Moot Court Tournament, hosted by the University of California, San Diego. They argued in three rounds against opponents from other schools across the country, including the Boston Latin School, which is the oldest school in the United States (established in 1635). The event lasted about five hours on Zoom. Although they did not advance to finals, they held their own under difficult questioning from the moot court judges. One of the judges, a Yale Law graduate who has argued several cases before the U.S. Supreme Court, complimented Jacob Cresson on his command of summary judgment law.

Jacob and Matthew both said they enjoyed the experience and expressed their gratitude.
