THE FIRST GYMNASIUM (ODEUM)

The Odeum.

Natatorium.

In connection with the gymnasium is a fine swimming-pool of generous dimensions. The continuous flow of an artesian well supplies it with water. During the cold months of winter they have at their disposal a suite of bathrooms on the ground floor of the dormitory.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE.

The following regulations are calculated to mould the character of the student, by checking and eliminating vicious habits and carefully directing the natural inclinations into proper channels:

1. Students are requested to show themselves respectful and obedient to the officers and professors of the College.
2. Expressions or acts injurious to good morals or religion are not tolerated.
3. Newspapers, books, pamphlets and pictures are to be handed to the President or his substitute, without whose approbation they cannot be introduced or kept.
4. All mail matter addressed to students or sent by them is liable to examination.
5. Unless it be for some special reason, letters should be written on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays only. All the students must write to their parents or guardians at least once a week.
6. Boarding students are forbidden to leave the College grounds without permission.
7. The use of tobacco in any form is prohibited. However, the seniors who furnish a written permit from their parents, may be allowed to smoke at certain times and under certain restrictions.
8. No leave of absence can be granted at Mardi-Gras.
9. No student shall keep in his possession any money, nor will the College authorities be responsible for any valuables, such as watches, jewelry, etc., unless deposited with the Treasurer.
10. The College is under Catholic direction. Non-Catholics, however, are admitted, provided they are willing, for the sake of order and uniformity, to be present and behave with due reverence at all public religious services.
11. Damage done to property, in or outside of the buildings, will be charged to the student causing such damage.
12. Bartering or selling of clothes, books or any other object, is strictly forbidden among the students.
